General Rules:

- 1. A student is allowed to participate for as many individual items as they like.
- 2. Each participant will be provided with a chest number and only this number will be used during the event.
- 3. An event will be conducted only if there are a minimum of three participants, otherwise that event will be cancelled.
- 4. NIV (New International Version) Bible is the standard version which will be used.
- 5. To be considered for the prize (the best three will be selected), a minimum of 60% marks is required.
- 6. Decisions of the Judges are final.
- 7. Event toppers for each category will be eligible to represent the Sunday School for Explore 2024.

Events

Events - General Guidelines

Solo Song – Malayalam & English

- The list of songs with Melody are saved on https://admtss.com/talent-search/
- Two songs will be given for Junior, Intermediate, Senior & Young Adult and the contestant will be asked to sing one song of the Judges' choice.
- In Nursery, Beginner & Primary only one song will be given.
- Qualifying round from Intermediate to Young Adult: Singing of given liturgy chants.
- All participants must sing either two stanzas (1 & 2) or one stanzas and chorus of the given song, as instructed by the Judges. This is applicable for both English and Malayalam Songs.
- For English Solo: Given notations shall be followed by Junior, Intermediate, Senior and Young Adult. No Song Notations for Nursery, Beginners and Primary.
- For Malayalam Solo: Given notations to be followed
- Valuations will be separate for Male and Female from Intermediate and above.
- Solo will be graded on the following categories
 - \circ $\,$ Notations / Tune/ Melody which is provided
 - o Pitch
 - o Clarity
 - Presentation
 - o Rhythm
- Improvisations not allowed for Solo English and Malayalam.
- Actions not allowed while singing.
- Only students of Junior, Intermediate Senior and Young Adult, may participate in both English and Malayalam Solo singing.

Story Telling

- The Bible stories will be shared a few weeks prior to the event.
- Specific Bible Story can be paraphrased. The time limit will be a maximum of 3 minutes.
- Hand movements and facial expressions are allowed. No action or Acting allowed.
- Participants to memorise the story and not dramatise the story.
- Stories will be graded on four Categories
 - Content how accurately the Biblical content is presented in story form.
 - Clarity- how clearly the words are spoken, language, flow of thought.
 - Presentation- voice modulation, body language, eye contact, expression, hand gestures.
 - Moral Application- how well the story is concluded to give a message of Christian life application.

Colouring

- Time limit 45 minutes
- Each child should bring their own crayons for Nursery Grade, and colour pencils in the other grades. Children should bring their own writing pads.
- The picture to be coloured will be provided.

Drawing

- Time limit 45 minutes
- Specific Biblical theme will be given at the time of drawing.
- Drawing Sheet will be provided.
- Each child should bring their own pencil, eraser, and writing pad.

Bible Reading

- Portion will be given at the time of reading.
- Podium will not be allowed
- The given portion should be taken within 1 min to qualify to read.
- This event will be graded on the following:
 - Quickness- how quickly the portion is taken
 - $\circ~$ Accuracy how correctly the portion is read
 - Clarity- how clearly read, voice modulation.
 - Presentation- how the Bible is held, opened, closed, manner of how the Bible is read, without shoes, head cover for girls, eye contact.

Elocution

- Topic will be given 15 minutes prior to the elocution.
- The speaker is not allowed to read the speech but use of small cards with points is allowed.
- Participants are allowed to carry the Holy Bible.
- Time limit will be maximum 5 Minutes and minimum time limits is 2:30 Minutes
- If the speech is above 5 minutes and less than 2:30 Minutes, then the participant is disqualified.
- A warning bell will ring after 4 minutes to notify the participant that only 1 minute left to conclude the speech.
- Elocution will be graded on the following:
 - Content ideas on the topic presented in the speech content of Introduction, body and conclusion.
 - Clarity- how clearly the speech is presented, language, flow of thought.
 - Presentation- voice modulation, body language, eye contact, expression, hand gestures.
 - Moral Application- How well Christian values are upheld throughout the speech

Essay Writing

- Topic will be given at the time of the event.
- Time limit will be 45 minutes and Minimum word count is 200.
