#### **TALENT SEARCH, Events, Portions and Guidelines-2025**

Circular No: ADMTSS/02/2025 Date: 28/04/2025

<u>Purpose:</u> To enable every child to develop their God given gifts for the glory of God in service to fellow believers and for their own spiritual growth in the Body of Christ.

#### **General Rules and Guidelines:**

- 1. Each student can participate in a maximum of three (3) individual items.
- 2. Each participant will be provided with a chest number and only this number will be used during the event.
- 3. NIV (New International Version) Bible is the standard version which will be used for bible reading.
- 4. There will be a preliminary round conducted for nursery, beginner, primary and junior singing and storytelling competition and the top 12 will participate in the final event.
- 5. To be considered for the prize, a minimum of 60% marks is required and the top three will be selected from each category.
- 6. Of the registered participants, if only one participant is appearing for the event, he/she will be awarded the first position.
- 7. Judging will be done based on Explore rules and the decisions of the Judges will be considered as final.
- 8. Event toppers for each category will be eligible to represent the Sunday School for Explore 2025.
- 9. Please note that all details in this circular regarding the Talent Search supersedes any previous information provided earlier.
- 10. Parents are requested to stay away from competition venues to avoid distraction during the course of competition. Capturing of videos is not allowed.

#### **SOLO SINGING – MALAYALAM & ENGLISH**

- The list of songs with tunes will be uploaded on : <a href="http://admtss.com/talent-search/">http://admtss.com/talent-search/</a>
- Two songs will be given for Junior, Intermediate, Senior & Young Adult and the contestant will be asked to sing one song of the Judges' choice.
- In Nursery, Beginner & Primary only one song will be given.
- All participants must sing either two stanzas (1 & 2) or 2 stanzas and chorus of the given song, unless otherwise instructed by the Judges. This is applicable for both English and Malayalam Songs.
- For Solo: Given notations shall be followed by Junior, Intermediate, Senior and Young Adult. No Song Notations for Nursery, Beginners and Primary.
- Valuations will be separate for Male and Female from Intermediate and above.
- Improvisations or actions are not allowed for Solo English and Malayalam.
- Only students of Junior, Intermediate, Senior and Young Adult, may participate in both English and Malayalam Solo singing.
- Solo will be graded on the following categories(the top 2 carry greater weightage)
  - Notations / Tune/ Melody which is provided
  - o Pitch
  - Clarity
  - Presentation
  - o Rhythm
  - For Nursery, Primary, Beginner and Junior there will be a preliminary round and only the 12 toppers from each category will be allowed to participate in the final event.

#### **Story Telling**

Beginner (1&2) :- "Joseph's Dreams" Genesis 37:5-11.

Primary (3 &4): "Elisha- The Prophet who saved the disciples" 2 Kings 4:38 – 41.

- Specific Bible Story can be paraphrased. The time limit will be a maximum of 3 minutes.
- Hand movements and facial expressions are allowed. No action or acting allowed.
- Participants are to memorise the story and not dramatise the story.
- For Primary and Beginner, and Junior there will be a preliminary round, and only the 12 toppers from each category will be allowed to participate in the final event.
- Stories will be graded on four Categories
- o Content how accurately the Biblical content is presented in a story form.
- o Clarity- how clearly the words are spoken, language, flow of thought.
- Presentation- voice modulation, body language, eye contact, expression and hand gestures.
- Moral Application- how well the story is concluded to give a message of Christian life application.

# Coloring (Time limit – 1 hour) – Nursery, Beginner, Primary

- Time limit 1 Hour
- Each child should bring their own color pencils, drawing pads and necessary stationary.
- The picture to be coloured will be provided.
- Grading Criteria
  - o Creativity & Color Harmony
  - o Neatness & Precision
  - o Theme Adherence
  - o Technique & Skill
  - Presentation

#### Drawing (Time limit - 1 hour) – Junior, Intermediate, Senior.

- Specific Biblical theme topic will be given at the time of drawing.
- Drawing Sheet will be provided.
- Each child should bring their own pencil, eraser, and writing pad.
- Grading Criteria
- Creativity & Originality
- Technical Skill
- Composition & layout
- o Adherence to the Theme
- Overall Impact

### Bible Reading - Junior, Intermediate, Senior, Young Adult

- Portion will be given at the time of reading.
- Podium will not be allowed.
- Bible will be provided.
- If the participant takes more than 1 minute to take the portion or the portion is read wrong the participant will be marked as disqualified.
- This event will be graded on the following
  - Quickness- how quickly the portion is taken.
  - Accuracy how correctly the portion is read.
  - o Clarity- how clearly read, voice modulation.
  - Presentation- how the Bible is held, opened, closed, manner in which the
     Bible is read, (without shoes, head cover for girls), eye contact.

## Elocution (Extempore) - Intermediate, Senior, Young Adult

- Topic will be given 15 minutes prior to the elocution.
- The speaker is not allowed to read the speech but use of small cards with points is allowed.
- Participants are allowed to carry the Holy Bible.
- Time limit will be maximum 5 Minutes and minimum time limit is 2:30 Minutes
- If the speech is above 5 minutes and less than 2:30 Minutes, then the participant is disqualified.
- A warning bell will ring after 4 minutes to notify the participant that only 1 minute left to conclude the speech.
- Elocution will be graded on the following:
  - Content ideas on the topic presented in the speech content of Introduction, body and conclusion.
  - o Clarity- how clearly the speech is presented, language, flow of thought.
  - Presentation- voice modulation, body language, eye contact, expression, hand gestures.
  - Moral Application- How well Christian values are upheld throughout the speech

# Essay Writing - Young Adult

- Topic will be given at the time of the event.
- Time limit will be 45 minutes and Minimum word count is 200
- Writing Sheet will be provided.
- Each child should bring their own necessary stationary and writing pad.
- Essay writing will be graded on the following:
  - Content
  - Clarity
  - o Presentation
  - Moral Application
